Headstart Puppy and Family Dog Training

Head Start Puppy Training Class will help you and your family communicate, manage and enrich your relationship with your dog. It's also the perfect time to help shy dogs become more confident and help bold or bossy puppies begin to develop impulse control in a structured and safe environment.

- Family members learn to manage puppy chewing, direct potty training, keep puppy safe and build strong communication skills with a consistent routine.
- Well mannered children are welcome.
- Puppies are required to have a clean bill of health from their veterinarian and at least two sets of initial vaccinations.

Family Dog Training Class is for dogs of all ages. This six week program will address common training and behavior challenges. Current vaccinations records are required.

- The class covers every-day manners such as "sit" and "settle down" as well as loose leash walking and coming when called and the appropriate way to greet humans; four feet on the floor.
 - An introduction to teaching tricks and navigating an obstacle course will add to the fun of family dog class.
 - Note: Dogs with serious reactivity issues may need special screening and training prior to attending a group class. Please call one of the instructors if you have questions or concerns.
